

Radio Script

SONIA: Hello and welcome to radio city, I am your host Sonia today I'd like to welcome a special guest star all the way from London, DJ Jo. I know most of you have listened to him mix songs but today he will be counting down he's top 10 favourite songs and we shall be taking some questions from he's fans. Don't touch that dial.

(10th track: Rita Ora - your song (3:01))

DJ JO: Hello Leicester, it's DJ Jo in the building and I am so happy to be here right now, thanks to the lady right here with me Sonia.

DJ JO: (Laughs) well yes I am a diverse person, I love getting to know different kind of people, their culture and background and in most cases songs describe who a person is and what they have gone through in their life.

SONIA: Okay Jo we shall be receiving some calls from the listeners and fans, the phone line is now open.

(Phone rings)

SONIA: Oh we have our first caller

Caller number 1: (shouts) my name is Jessica I am a big fan of DJ Jo and my question is, where do you get ideas of mixing your songs?

DJ JO: (smiles) well Jessica, thank you for the question, I actually grew up with the love for being a DJ and being able to listen to a couple of songs and mixing them.

Caller number 2: Hello, my name is Khan and my question is, at what age were you when you made your first mix?

DJ JO: Thank you for the question Khan, I was about the age of 18 when I made my first music mix.

SONIA: Those were some nice questions from you guys, we are going to DJ Jos top 5 songs on he's countdown we'll be back for more questions after this. Don't touch that dial.

(Phone rings)

DJ JO: I take about 8 hours to come up with something good and I first listen to the mix before anyone else gets to listen to it and if I do not like it I edit it and put some additions to it to make it good to listen to.

SONIA: Nice, I actually wanted to ask you this question but thank you Mike for asking.

(Phone rings)

Caller number 4: My name is Cate and I would like to know whether you do the mixes all on your own or you have some people who help you with your mixes.

DJ JO: hello Cate thank you for the question and yes I do the mixes on my own and when I have made a mix, my team listens to it and if it needs some changes I am told and I change what I have to change.

SONIA: Thank you all so much for the questions the phone line is now closed and we are going to DJ Jos top 3 songs.

(3rd track: Marron 5 – what lovers do (3:34)

(2nd track: French Montana – Unforgettable (4:47)

SONIA: It has been so great having you in the studio as we are winding up with your countdown. The songs have been great. Is there anything you would like to say before we play your number one song?

DJ JO: Yes off course, I'd like to thank all the listeners who have been able to listen to my countdown and to all the people who have helped me get to where I am and I advise all the people out their listening is to never give up on your dreams, you never know where they will take you. Thank you all for your support.
